



# OTHER PROGRAM & SERVICES

## 1. Mutual Aid

BMPC provides a mortuary aid to the beavered family of a regular member in the amount of Six Thousand Pesos (Php6,000.00), provided he or she has atleast Two Thousand Five Hundred Pesos (Php 2,500.00) Share Capital.

## 2. LEMOS (Legitimate Mortuary System)

A death aid benefit of up to Fifteen Thousand Pesos for those who register and paid a registration fee of Two Hundred Fifty Pesos (Php 250.00). Beneficiaries can claim the death aid benefits depending on the tenure of LEMOS membership upon the member's death amounting to wit:

### Benefits:

Below 1 Year	Php 6, 500.00
Above 1 Year – 3 Years	Php 7, 500.00
Above 3 Years – 5 Years	Php 10, 000.00
Above 5 Years	Php 15, 000.00

## 3. COLISAP (COOP Life Savings Program)

### COLISAP 40K

Open to all associate and regular members of not more than 59 ½ years old. The participant must have a savings deposit maintaining balance of not less than Php 500.00. In case of death of the program participant, the beneficiary shall receive Php 40, 000.00 which shall contributed by all program participants.

### COLISAP 60K

Open to all associate and regular members of not more than 59 ½ years old. The participant must have a savings deposit maintaining balance of not less than Php 2, 000.00. In case of death of the program participant, the beneficiary shall receive Php 60, 000.00 which shall contributed by all program participants.

## 4. FONUS (COOP Funeral Care)

A COOP-owned, and COOP-managed funeral event planning and management enterprise.

\* An additional of Php 10, 000.00 to the member's mortuary claim if the beneficiaries prefers the services of the Coop Funeral Care.

## 5. CLIMBS Life and General Insurance Cooperative

Is a composite insurance cooperative owned by 2000 cooperatives in the Philippines including the Barbaza MPC. It advocates a well integrated coop insurance system: Life, Non-Life and Health.

## 6. One Coop Health

One COOP Health is a Health Maintenance Organizations. An HMO is an organization that offers managed healthcare programs for its members through accredited physicians, hospitals and clinics.

## **7. PhilHealth Subsidy iGroup Program**

Barbaza MPC subsidizes the Philhealth Contribution of its indigent members under Philhealth iGroup Program.

## **8. PhilHealth Collection Services**

Members and Non-Members can now pay their quarterly premiums with no added charges at any Barbaza MPC Office.

# **OTHER ENTERPRISES**

## **1. Cable TV & Internet Services**

Member-subscribers can now enjoy 81 Digital Television Channel Program on news, education, sports and entertainment for as low as Php360.00 monthly subscription. Cable with internet is now available in Barbaza to Hamtic Area for a minimum of only Php1,030.00 monthly subscription.

## **2. Coop Ocean View Resort & Restaurant**

Barbaza MPC's undertaking in building a Resort and Restaurant in the town of Barbaza is to provide and offer relaxation, recreation and good meals to the town's people and visitors and to support the eco tourism and economic enterprise of the town.

## **3. Coop Pharmacy**

Barbaza MPC's venture in pharmacy help the community have access to quality yet affordable medicines.

## **4. Marketing & Trading Services**

This program reaches out specially to its farmer-members through palay/rice trading and by providing post harvest facilities such as warehouses and solar dryers. Barbaza MPC is also engaged in financing hybrid rice/corn and abaca fiber production and marketing of products utilizing its wide range of marketing linkages.

## **5. Otoshi-ami Project**

This project aims to provide additional source of income to the fisher folks. Barbaza MPC develop and operationalized the project located in Brgy. Ipil, Barbaza, Antique utilizing local fishermen-members as regular fishermen-laborers.

## **6. Gas Station**

Barbaza MPC engages in Gas Refilling through franchising by SeaOil Philippines. This is to extend its services to members motorists and those who use fuel energy in their livelihood with advance patronage.
